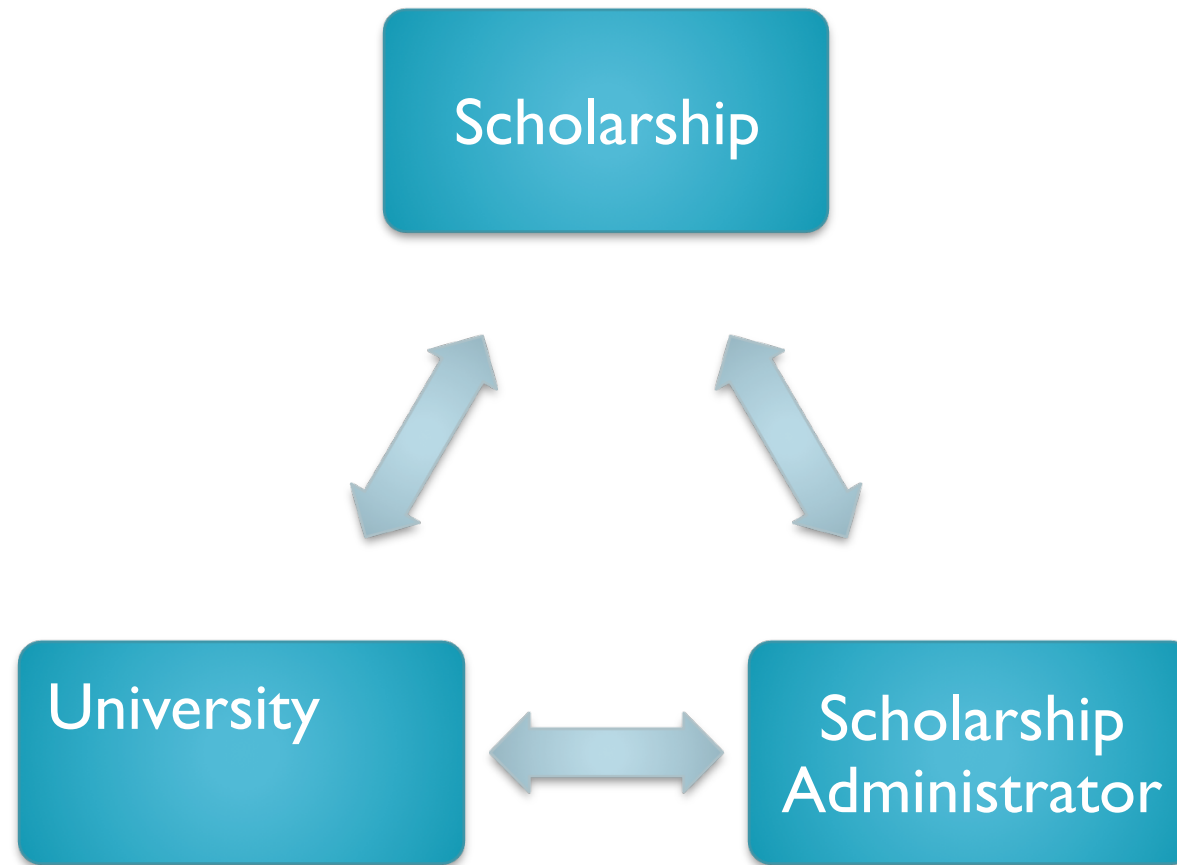
6. Main Scholarship Requirements

1. Criteria satisfy the admission of each institution (recognized degree, good transcript [GPA>3.7])
2. Cambodian National (Age between 18 and 42 years old)
3. Have appropriate background
4. Committed to the development of Cambodia

Scholarship Requirements (Cont.)

5. English Proficiency (IELT >6.5 or TOEFL >550)
6. Qualified Student
7. Good Communication Skills
8. Willing to learn new things and contribute to the development of Cambodia and community
